

Frequently Asked Questions	
GENERAL	
What is Dancefest?	DANCEFEST is an Ontario-wide Dance festival for secondary students to celebrate and develop their passion and skill for the art of dancing. <b>Students will choreograph</b> <b>and perform routines</b> , receive feedback from professional adjudicators, take part in a variety of workshops run by some of Canada's top professional dancers and choreographers, and will celebrate their hard work and achievements at a final banquet and awards ceremony.
Can teachers choreograph dance entries at Dancefest?	No. We are focused on showcasing and adjudicating <b>STUDENT</b> choreographed pieces only.
What is your refund policy for participant fees and/or dance entry fees?	We <b>DO NOT</b> offer refunds once fees are paid. Unfortunately, since we are a not-for-profit organization and we cover many of our event costs ahead of the event (which changes based on the number of participants), we are unable to afford refunds.
If my school has only one routine, can we join the event for just one day?	While Dancefest includes a competition component, the greatest experience for students really comes from attending the events outside of the competition. The interactions with other schools, attending the social dance and banquet, our freestyle event, the professional workshops and even staying on campus in a residence, are all components of the unique experience of attending Dancefest and a large part of what we offer and focus the experience on compared to other dance competitions. While you can choose to attend for a day, you really would miss out on the majority of what this event is really about and the growth and experience that would be offered for dancers that attend the entire event.
Do you sell MERCH?	Yes! We offer Merch ahead of our event from our ONLINE STORE and a small selection of merch at the event itself. If you are wanting to make sure you have access to merch, it is recommended you order ahead of time (keep an eye on instagram for the opening of our online store!) to receive that merch upon arrival at the event.

What if I am unsure about which level of performance a dance entry is?	Use a combination of the level descriptions and the teacher's professional judgment.

Can students choreograph a dance but not perform in it?	Yes, students can choreograph a piece that they do not perform in.

Are all workshops for all levels of dance?	Yes, we inform workshop leaders to prepare open level workshops to accommodate all learning levels
