The **videos** share **warm-ups/cooldowns; choreography for a specific dance style**; and a **personal video** of the professional dance artist. Artists shared their personal journey - education; when their passion for dance began; dance training; challenges; celebrations; career before COVID; plans after COVID; how they coped during the pandemic; and, how they have continued to dance.

We hope you will take advantage of these wonderful educational resources. We feel very fortunate to have secured these tremendously talented dance artists to share their innovative artistry with us during the extremely challenging times of the pandemic for the performing arts.
