Highest Artistic Performances	This recognition is achieved based on the highest average of <u>artistic marks</u> from a minimum of 3 dance entries with 3 different styles of dance and 3 different levels of performance.
MOST OUTSTANDING SCHOOL	This recognition is achieved based on the highest average of COMBINED <u>technical AND artistry marks</u> from 3 dance entries with 3 different styles of dance and 3 different levels of performance.
Laurel Brown Spirit Award	This award recognizes a school who constantly embodies the values of collaboration, support, and positivity at the OSSDF event. This school goes above and beyond to foster a sense of unity, encouragement, and camaraderie among participants at OSSDF. Their infectious enthusiasm and generous positive spirit makes them a true catalyst for morale and cohesion amongst participants.
